Allah's Name to commence with, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

93:1. By the oath of the forenoon.

وَالضُّحَىٰ ۙ

93:2. And by the night when it covers (everything with its darkness).

وَاللَّيْلِ إِذَا سَجَىٰ ۙ

93:3. That your Lord has neither abandoned you (O Beloved), nor did He dislike you.

مَا وَدَّعَكَ رَبُّكَ وَمَا قَلَىٰ ۙ

93:4. And indeed, the latter is better for you than the former.

وَلَلْآخِرَةُ خَيْرٌ لَّكَ مِنَ الْأُولَىٰ ۝٤

93:5. And indeed, it is close that your Lord will give you so much that you will be pleased.

وَلَسَوْفَ يُعْطِيكَ رَبُّكَ فَتَرْضَىٰ ۝٥

93:6. Did He not find you (O Beloved as) an orphan, then provided you with a place?

93:7. And (He) found you profoundly engrossed in His love, so He gave you way towards Himself (i.e. further towards His closeness).

93:9. Therefore, do not put pressure on an orphan.

93:10. And do not scold a beggar.

وَأَمَّا السَّائِلَ فَلَا تَنْهَرْ ۝١٠

93:11. And publicise well the bounty of your Lord.
