81:25. And the Qur'aan is not the recitation of Satan, the banished one.

وَمَا هُوَ بِقَوْلِ شَيْطَانٍ رَّجِيمٍ ﴿٢٥﴾

81:26. Then, where are you going to (whilst leaving the Qur'aan)?

فَأَيْنَ تَذْهَبُونَ ﴿٢٦﴾

81:27. Only that (i.e. the Qur'aan) is guidance to all the worlds.

إِنْ هُوَ إِلَّا ذِكْرٌ لِلْعَالَمِينَ ﴿٢٧﴾

81:28. For the one amongst you who desires to become upright.

لِمَنْ شَاءَ مِنْكُمْ أَنْ يَسْتَقِيمَ ﴿٢٨﴾

81:29. And (in reality) what can you desire, unless it is willed by Allah; the Lord of all the worlds.

وَمَا تَشَاءُونَ إِلَّا أَنْ يَشَاءَ اللَّهُ رَبُّ الْعَالَمِينَ ﴿٢٩﴾

Allah's Name to commence with, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

82:1. When the sky has split open.

إِذَا السَّمَاءُ انْفَطَرَتْ ۙ

82:2. And when the stars have fallen.

وَإِذَا الْكَوَاكِبُ انْتَثَرَتْ ۙ

82:3. And when the oceans are caused to flow away.

وَإِذَا الْبِحَارُ فُجِّرَتْ ۙ

82:4. And when the graves are scraped off (and the dead would be resurrected).

وَإِذَا الْقُبُورُ بُعْثِرَتْ ۙ

82:5. Every soul will come to know what it has sent ahead and what it has left behind.

عَلِمَتْ نَفْسٌ مَّا قَدَّمَتْ وَأَخَّرَتْ ۙ

82:6. O mankind! What has deceived you (and took you away) from your Lord, the Most Generous?

يَا أَيُّهَا الْإِنْسَانُ مَا غَرَّبَكَ بِرَبِّكَ
الْكَرِيمِ ۙ

82:7. The One Who created you, then made you perfectly, then proportioned you.

الَّذِي خَلَقَكَ فَسَوَّاكَ فَعَدَلَكَ ۙ

82:8. He formed you into whatever shape He willed.

فِي أَيِّ صُورَةٍ مَّا سَاءَ رَأَىٰكَ ۙ

82:9. Never (become arrogant)! Rather, you belie the establishment of justice (i.e. the Day of Judgement).

كَلَّا بَلْ تُكَدِّبُونَ بِالذِّينِ ۙ

82:10. And there are some guardians indeed (appointed) over you.

وَإِنَّ عَلَيْكُمْ لَحَافِظِينَ ۙ

82:11. The honourable scribes
(i.e. Kiraaman Kaatibeen).

كِرَامًا كَاتِبِينَ ﴿١١﴾

82:12. That they know whatever
you do.

يَعْلَمُونَ مَا تَفْعَلُونَ ﴿١٢﴾

82:13. Indeed, the righteous are
definitely in the serenity (of
Paradise).

إِنَّ الْأَبْرَارَ لَفِي نَعِيمٍ ﴿١٣﴾

82:14. And indeed, the
wrongdoers are definitely in
Hell.

وَالَّذِينَ كَفَرُوا لَفِي جَحِيمٍ ﴿١٤﴾

82:15. They (i.e. the
disbelievers) will enter it on the
Day of justice.

يَصْلَوْنَهَا يَوْمَ الدِّينِ ﴿١٥﴾

82:16. And they will not be able
to hide from it.

وَمَا هُمْ عَنْهَا بِغَائِبِينَ ﴿١٦﴾

82:17. And what do you know
how the Day of Justice is?

وَمَا أَدْرَاكَ مَا يَوْمَ الدِّينِ ﴿١٧﴾

82:18. Again, what do you
know how the Day of Justice is?

ثُمَّ مَا أَدْرَاكَ مَا يَوْمَ الدِّينِ ﴿١٨﴾

82:19. The Day when no soul
will have the authority for any
other soul (to help, without the
permission of Allah); and on
that Day, all command belongs
to Allah.
