

## 78. SURAH AL-NABA (THE NEWS)

(This Surah is Makkan, containing 40 verses and 2 sections)

Allah's Name to commence with, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

78:1. What are they asking each other?

عَمَّ يَتَسَاءَلُونَ ﴿١﴾

78:2. (They are asking) about the great news.

عَنِ النَّبَاِ الْعَظِيمِ ﴿٢﴾

78:3. Regarding which they have different views.

الَّذِي هُمْ فِيهِ مُخْتَلِفُونَ ﴿٣﴾

78:4. Yes, certainly! Soon they will come to know.

كَلَّا سَيَعْلَمُونَ ﴿٤﴾

78:5. Then yes, certainly! They will come to know.

ثُمَّ كَلَّا سَيَعْلَمُونَ ﴿٥﴾

78:6. Did We not make the earth a bed?

أَلَمْ نَجْعَلِ الْأَرْضَ مِهْدًا ﴿٦﴾

78:7. And the mountains as pegs (to anchor the earth)?

وَالْجِبَالَ أَوْتَادًا ﴿٧﴾

78:8. And (We) have created you in pairs.

وَخَلَقْنَاكُمْ أَزْوَاجًا ﴿٨﴾

78:9. And (We) made your sleep a (means of) rest.

وَجَعَلْنَا نَوْمَكُمْ سُبَاتًا ﴿٩﴾

78:10. And (We) made the night a covering.

وَجَعَلْنَا اللَّيْلَ لِبَاسًا ۝١٠

78:11. And (We) made the day for seeking livelihood.

وَجَعَلْنَا النَّهَارَ مَعَاشًا ۝١١

78:12. And (We) built seven strong structures (i.e. skies) above you.

وَبَيْنَنَا فَوْقَكُمْ سَبْعًا شَدَادًا ۝١٢

78:13. And therein (We) have kept an intensely bright lamp (i.e. the sun).

وَجَعَلْنَا سِرَاجًا وَهَّاجًا ۝١٣

78:14. And (We) sent down heavy rain from the clouds.

وَأَنْزَلْنَا مِنَ الْمُعْصِرَاتِ مَاءً ثَجَّاجًا ۝١٤

78:15. That (We) may produce grain and vegetation therewith.

لِنُخْرِجَ بِهِ حَبًّا وَنَبَاتًا ۝١٥

78:16. And dense gardens.

وَجَنَّاتٍ أَلْفَافًا ۝١٦

78:17. Indeed, the Day of decision has a fixed time.

إِنَّ يَوْمَ الْفُصْلِ كَانَ مِيقَاتًا ۝١٧

78:18. The Day when the Trumpet will be blown, you will therefore come forth in troops upon troops.

يَوْمَ يُنْفَخُ فِي الصُّورِ فَتَأْتُونَ أَفْوَاجًا ۝١٨

78:19. And the sky will be opened, that it will become (a sky with) gates.

وَفُتِحَتِ السَّمَاءُ فَكَانَتْ أَبْوَابًا ۝١٩

78:20. And the mountains will be driven, that they will become like shining sand (as a mirage) which gives the false impression of water from afar.

وَسُيِّرَتِ الْجِبَالُ فَكَانَتْ سَرَابًا ۝٢٠

78:21. Indeed, Hell is lying in ambush (for the disbelievers).

إِنَّ جَهَنَّمَ كَانَتْ مِرْصَادًا ۝٢١

78:22. (Hell is) the destination of the rebellious.

لِلظَّالِمِينَ مَا بَأْسًا ۝٢٢

78:23. Therein they will remain for a never-ending period.

لِيَشِينَ فِيهَا أَحْقَابًا ۝٢٣

78:24. They will not taste anything cold therein nor anything to drink.

لَا يَذُوقُونَ فِيهَا بَرْدًا وَلَا شَرَابًا ۝٢٤

78:25. Except for boiling water and the burning pus (discharged) of the people of Hell.

إِلَّا حَيْبًا وَعَسَاقًا ۝٢٥

78:26. As an appropriate recompense (for their misdeeds).

جَزَاءً وَفَاتًا ۝٢٦

78:27. Indeed, they had no fear of reckoning.

إِنَّهُمْ كَانُوا لَا يَرْجُونَ حِسَابًا ۝٢٧

78:28. And they belied Our verses to the extreme.

وَكَذَّبُوا بِالآيَاتِنَا كَذَابًا ۝٢٨

78:29. And We have noted down everything, keeping it counted.

وَكُلَّ شَيْءٍ أَحْصَيْنَاهُ كِتَابًا ۝٢٩



78:30. Now taste (the punishment), that We shall not increase for you except the punishment.

فَذُوقُوا فَلَنْ نَزِيدَكُمْ إِلَّا عَذَابًا ﴿٣٠﴾

78:31. Indeed, for those who fear (Allah) is a place of success.

إِنَّ لِلْمُتَّقِينَ مَفَازًا ﴿٣١﴾

78:32. (There) are Gardens and grapes.

حَدَآئِقٍ وَأَعْنَابًا ﴿٣٢﴾

78:33. And very attractive maidens of equal age.

وَكَوَاعِبَ أَتْرَابًا ﴿٣٣﴾

78:34. And an overflowing cup (of pure wine).

وَكَأْسًا دِهَاقًا ﴿٣٤﴾

78:35. In which they shall hear neither vulgar talk nor belying (of each other).

لَا يَسْمَعُونَ فِيهَا لُعَاوًا وَلَا جَدَابًا ﴿٣٥﴾

78:36. A reward from your Lord; the most sufficient bestowal.

جَزَاءً مِّن رَّبِّكَ عَطَاءً حَسَابًا ﴿٣٦﴾

78:37. (From) the One Who is the Lord of the heavens and the earth and whatever is in between; the Most Gracious, with Whom no one will have the power to talk (without His permission).

رَبِّ السَّمٰوٰتِ وَالْاَرْضِ وَمَا بَيْنَهُمَا  
الرَّحْمٰنِ لَا يَبْلُغُونَ مِنْهُ حُطْبًا ﴿٣٧﴾

78:38. The Day when Jibra'eel and all the angels will stand in rows; no one will be able to speak except the one whom the Most Gracious permitted (to speak) and who had spoken rightly.

يَوْمَ يَقُومُ الرُّوْحُ وَالْمَلٰئِكَةُ صَفًّا  
لَّا يَتَكَلَّمُونَ اِلَّا مَن اٰذِنَ لَهُ الرَّحْمٰنُ  
وَقَالَ صَوَابًا ﴿٣٨﴾

78:39. That is the true Day; now whoever wishes to may take the path towards his Lord.

ذٰلِكَ الْيَوْمُ الْحَقُّ فَمَنْ شَاءَ اتَّخَذْ  
اِلٰى رَبِّهِ مَا بَا ۝۳۹

78:40. We warn you of a punishment that has come near; a Day on which man will see whatever his hands have sent ahead, and the disbeliever will say, 'Alas! Had I somehow become dust (so I would not have to face the punishment).'

اِنَّا اَنْذَرْنٰكُمْ عَذَابًا قَرِيبًا يَوْمَ  
يَنْظُرُ الْمَرْءُ مَا قَدَّمَتْ يَدُوْهُ وَيَقُوْلُ  
الْكُفْرُ يَلِيْتَنِيْ كُنْتُ تُرَابًا ۝۴۰

### 79. SURAH AL-NAAZI'AAT (THE SOUL REMOVERS)

(This Surah is Makkan, containing  
46 verses and 2 sections)

۷۹ سُورَةُ النَّازِعَاتِ مَكِّيَّةٌ ۸۱  
اَيَاتُهَا ۴۶ رُكُوْعَاتُهَا ۲

Allah's Name to commence with, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.

بِسْمِ اللّٰهِ الرَّحْمٰنِ الرَّحِیْمِ

79:1. By the oath of those (angels) who harshly extract the soul (of the disbelievers).

وَالنَّازِعَاتِ غُرُقًا ۝۱

79:2. And (by those) who untie knots (i.e. remove the souls of believers) gently.

وَالشَّاطِطِّ نَسْفًا ۝۲

79:3. And (by those) who float (in the heavens and the earth) with ease.

وَالسَّيِّحَاتِ سَبْحًا ۝۳
